COVID Guidelines

SANITIZING & HAND WASHING

- At check-in, campers and staff will be required to wash or sanitize their hands: when At Check In
- Before and after activities or using any shared equipment
- Before and after eating lunch or snack
- All Staff are required to adhere to a clean facility. This means doing their part in frequently spot checking, sanitizing, and wiping down all shared equipment.
- All staff shall cover coughs and sneezes with tissues or the corner of the elbow. Children shall be encouraged, when appropriate to cover coughs and sneezes with tissues or the corner of the elbow, and soiled tissues shall be disposed immediately after use

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- Camp groups are limited to 10 and will not intermingle
- Appropriate social distancing strategies shall be implemented amongst staff and campers
- Campers will participate in all games and activities with their camp group and will not switch groups throughout the day

TEMPERATURE CHECKS & WELLNESS

- All staff and children are required to be screened for any observable illness, including cough or respiratory distress, and to confirm temperature below 100 degrees Fahrenheit.
- Campers will be dropped off at a pre-determined area. Campers' temperatures will be taken via a forehead thermometer. Temperature will be documented on attendance form.
- Staff or children who have a temperature greater than 100 degrees are not permitted into the program per Executive Order 7Q.
- If at any point the camper has a temperature over 100.4, they will be isolated until parents or guardians can pick them up.
- If at any point throughout the camp day a camper starts to present symptoms, the camper will be brought to the designated isolation area. (Symptoms: Fever, Chills, Repeated shaking with chills, Muscle pain, Headache, Sore throat, New loss of taste or smell)

DROP OFF AND PICK UP

- One parent only should be at drop off.
- Camper will sanitize their hands and be sent to their assigned camp group
- Pick up: One parent only should pick up
- Please send your child with a lunch with cold pack
- Please ensure that your child uses the restrooms at your home PRIOR to coming to camp

FACE MASKS

- Staff must wear masks/shields
- Campers do not have to wear a face mask

EQUIPMENT & GAME PLAY

- Camps will focus on non-contact, skill building activities
- Sharing of equipment is discouraged. Campers should bring their own (basketball, bats, baseballs, gloves, sticks, helmets, balls, etc)
- Camper's belongings should be kept in their backpacks.
- Backpacks will be kept 6 feet apart
- Each camper should bring their own water bottle labeled with their name. They will not be allowed to use the water fountains at any of our facilities.

WATERFRONT

- All patrons must wear a mask when entering the facility for check-in
- Social Distancing must be practiced between groups of patrons of at least 6 feet apart
- The locker room will remain closed. Guests are encouraged to come prepared to swim as there will be no changing facilities. Restroom will be frequently cleaned and sanitized.
- Wearing of masks is encouraged by all patrons if 6 feet of social distancing cannot be maintained.
- Lifeguard chairs will be delineated with a 6 foot barrier.
- Lifeguard equipment will be cleaned and sanitized after every use.
- Waterfront staff will wear masks or face coverings when they are entering, exiting, or moving around work or common areas where contact with others cannot be avoided. Face coverings should not be utilized when lifeguards are engaging in water rescue activities.
